A standard Honeywell programmable heat/cool digital thermostat is included for simple temperature control.



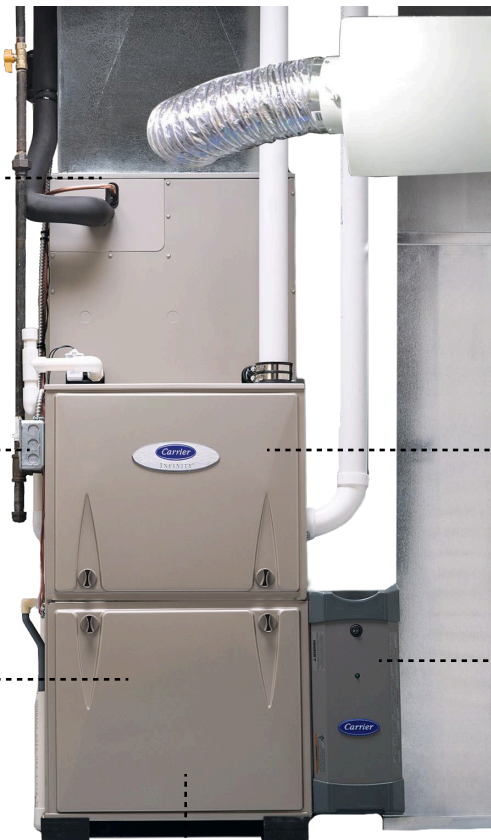

What's Not Included in Your Furnace Installation

We're transparent about potential extra costs due to unforeseen condition. Certain items may be required during the installation, which are not included in the standard replacement package:



Concrete Coring

If venting requires passing through a concrete foundation wall, additional costs for concrete coring (\$199 + GST per hole) may apply.



Ceiling and Bulkhead Repairs

Any required cutting into ceilings or bulkheads for venting installation is the homeowner's responsibility for repairs.



Thermostat Compatibility

Advanced thermostat upgrades (e.g., ecobee premium) or rewiring for zone control systems may incur additional charges.



Fishing Wire/Cable

Installing wiring may require cutting into drywall or ceilings; the homeowner is responsible for drywall repairs.



Electrical Exclusions

Modifications such as rewiring thermostats or upgrading control wiring are not included and may incur additional charges..



Drainage & Plumbing

Comfort Union does not handle plumbing or drainage creation; a condensate pump (\$190 + GST) may be necessary.



Existing Deficiencies

Comfort Union is not responsible for pre-existing deficiencies in plumbing, electrical, or sheet metal that may become apparent during installation.



Connecting Existing Components

We are not responsible for damages to existing components (humidifiers, UV lights, filters, thermostat, air conditioner, etc.) or their compatibility with the new system.
